The font type shall be Times New Roman; while the font size shall be 11 pt, except for author's names and affiliations which shall be 10 pt. The margins shall be 1.5" for the top and 1" for the sides and bottom. The Abstract title must be all capitals and bold. The names of the Author(s) shall follow the title but with one space in between. Enumerate the Affiliations and email addresses of the authors one space after the names of the authors, superscript-numbered accordingly as they appear in the authors' line. The presenting author shall be indicated by an asterisk. Each submitted Abstract Shall indicate the *Thematic Area* to which it must be included; and it shall also indicate the *Abstract Category*. These two lines shall be in double spacing. The Abstract body shall then follow with two blank spaces after the abstract shall be written in 1.5 spacing to a maximum of 300 words. The abstract should briefly establish the topic, give the research problem and/or main objective of the research, indicate the methodology used, present the main findings, and present the main conclusions. Recommendations may also be included. After the Abstract body, provide 1.5 spacing and then write 3 to 5 keywords.
